

GRESB Infrastructure Assessments

The GRESB Infrastructure Assessments are ESG engagement and benchmarking tools for institutional investors, fund managers, infrastructure companies and asset operators working in the infrastructure space. There are two complementary assessments, a Fund Assessment and an Asset Assessment. Both assessments address critical aspects of ESG performance through a standardized, globally applicable, reporting and benchmarking framework. The Assessments focus on operating investments, infrastructure assets, companies and funds, and cover the full breadth of infrastructure sectors, including:

- Data Infrastructure
- Energy Resources
- Environmental Services
- Network Utilities
- Power Generation excluding Renewables

- Renewable Power
- Social Infrastructure
- Transport
- Other

The GRESB Infrastructure Assessments provide investors with actionable information and tools to monitor and manage the ESG risks and opportunities of their investments, and prepare for increasingly rigorous ESG obligations. Assessment participants receive comparative business intelligence on where they stand against their peers, a roadmap with the actions they can take to improve their ESG performance and a communication platform to engage with investors.
